Stylized Looks in Katana Overview

In Katana there are 2 ways to setup Stylized Looks:

1. A simple "beginner" Macro that has everything in it.

2.	A more advanced manual of	option for the user to set ev	erything up manually, wit	th more control and daisv	/-chain options.

In the macro, there are 3 nodes: Toon, Hatching, and Lines.

Outside the macro, there is also the StylizedControl node, which is connected to PxrSurface like this:
