

# Upgrading to 2.1

## Query API Change

Due to a change in the underlying database schema, the `invocations()` function in the query API now returns a blade ID under the key of `bladeid` instead of the blade name under the key `blade`. Scripts requiring the blade name can obtain it by specifying `Blade.name` in the `columns` keyword parameter.

```
>>> invos = tq.invocations(search_clause, columns=["Blade.name"])
>>> print invos[0]["Blade.name"]
```
